Once upon a time, Saskatchewan people banded together believing that a cable company could do more than entertain the community. **It could better it.**


Over 40 years later, our community-owned co-operative continues to invest every penny we earn right back into this province.

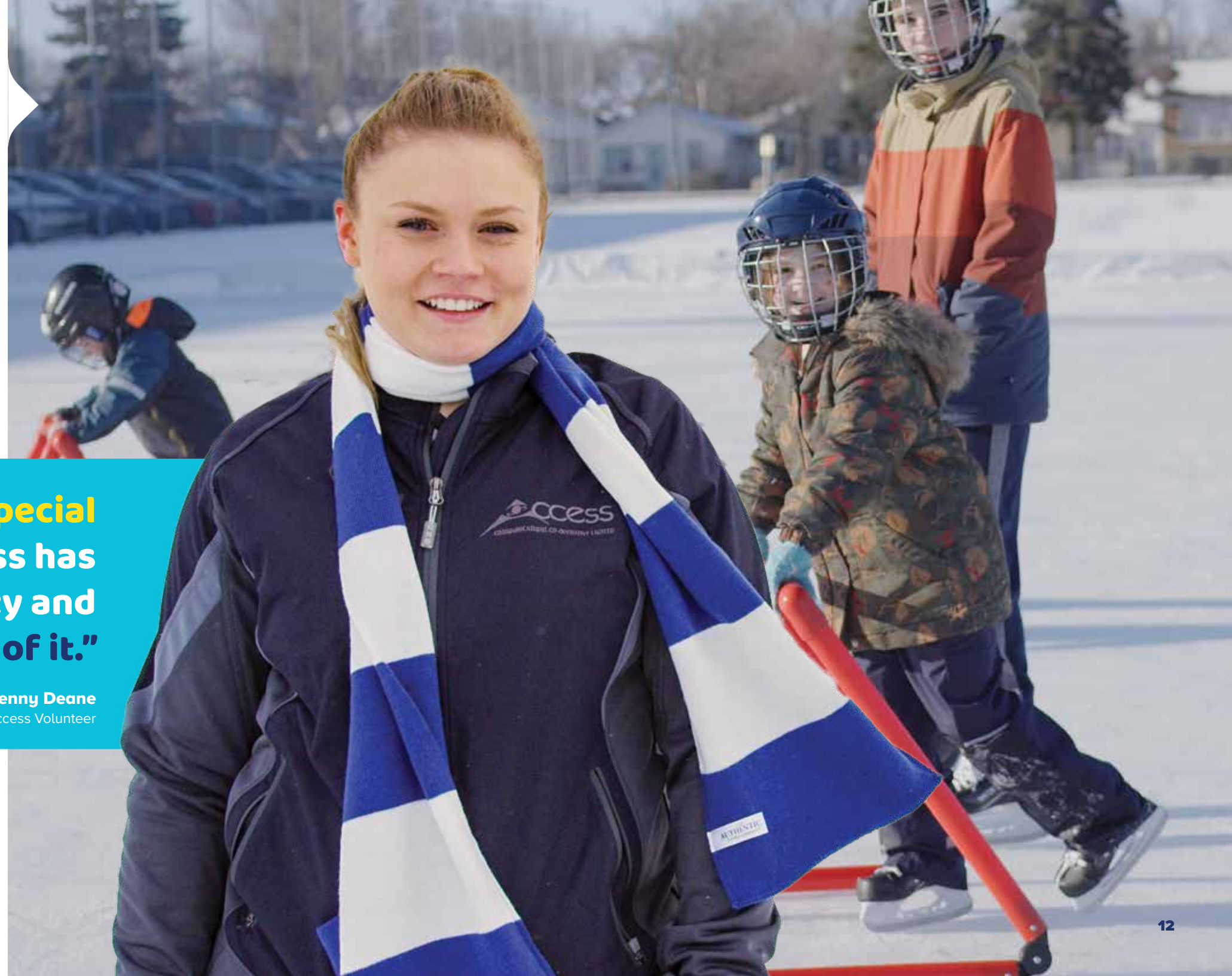

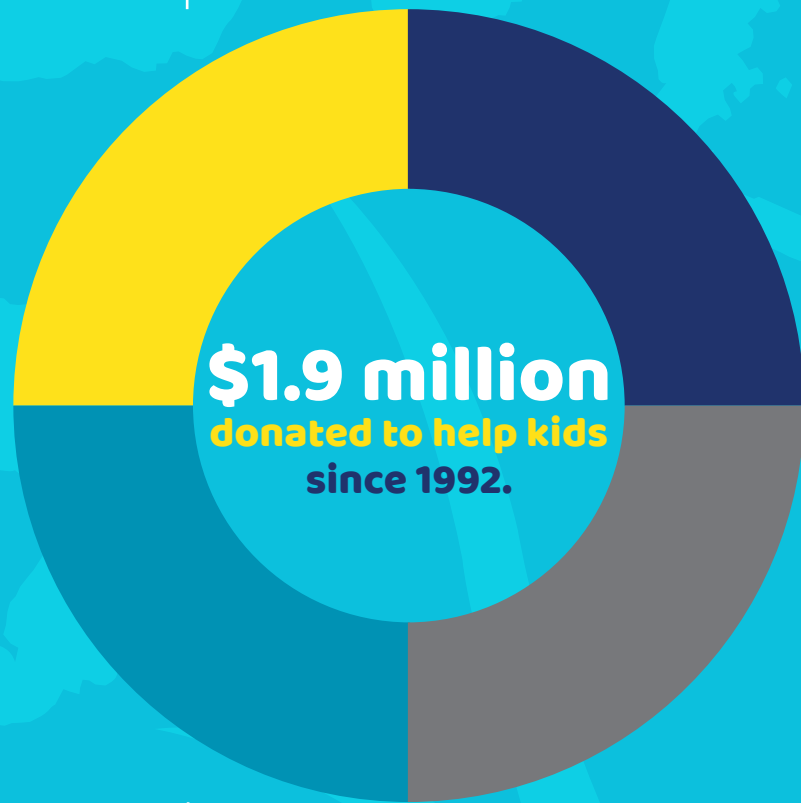

Reading the summary financial statements and the auditor's report thereon, therefore, is not a substitute for reading the Entity's audited financial statements and the auditor's report thereon.

The summary financial statements and the audited financial statements do not reflect the effects of events that occurred subsequent to the date of our report on the audited financial statements.

On our report dated March 25, 2019:

- We expressed a qualified opinion on the audited financial statements because we were not able to obtain sufficient appropriate evidence regarding the completeness of revenue from fundraising activities.

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on whether the summary financial statements are consistent, in all material respects, the audited financial statements based on our procedures, which were conducted in accordance with Canadian Auditing Standards 810, Engagements to Report on Summary Financial Statements.
